INTRODUCTION

Cherry's Early Learning Centre offers you a high quality childcare and education service in a natural, caring, and safe home-like environment.

We provide a daily programme of free-play alternatives and planned activities, based on the children's interests and an inquiry learning approach to our current projects.

Our curriculum basis is Te Whariki and our focus is on children's wellbeing, communication, belonging, contribution and exploration.

Our Centre is an Enviroschool and we adhere to the principles of sustainability in all our practises.

OUR PHILOSOPHY

Tamariki are **taonga tuku iho**, treasures handed down from our tipuna. Working in **partnership** kaiako and whānau hold these taonga close, nurturing and **protecting** them, while encouraging them to be curious about te Ao and their place in it. Whānau, as **pou whakahirahira** - the most important post, are valued for their wealth of diverse talents and are encouraged to **participate** in the care and education of their tamariki.

Cherry's Centres are Enviroschools where sustainable practices, both environmentally, and ethically, form a central pou of our beliefs and practices. We provide a nurturing and homelike learning environment in a play-garden setting, where tamariki are encouraged to be the kaitiaki of Papatuanuku and of each other.

Our acknowledgement of **Te Tiriti** o Waitangi; and the importance of authenticating te reo, tikanga and matauranga Māori supports us in our kaitiakitanga and in allowing our tamariki to appreciate the bicultural heritage that is theirs as young New Zealanders.

INVOLVEMENT BY PARENTS / WHANAU

You are welcome to be involved in our centre programme by:

- Spending time at the centre with your child
- Sharing your expertise with our children and centre community
- Collaborating with teachers on your child's learning by contributing stories to your child's profile books, contributing to our documentation panels, and giving informal verbal feedback about your child
- Attending social functions and educational evenings offered by the centre
- Parent helping on excursions
- Taking part in our Policy review process by reading policies put out for review and commenting on these
- Being part of our enviroschools project and embracing our sustainable practices, including waste free lunchboxes.

HOURS

8.00 am to 5.00 pm. Please arrive no later than 4.55 pm as we close at 5pm sharp. Our teachers leave at 5pm also.

FOOD

Please provide lunch in a named lunchbox, and morning and afternoon teas in a smaller named box.

We do provide drinks in real porcelain cups and children have access to water. Plastic drink bottles are not encouraged. We have a waste free lunch box policy, please read our brochure.

Celebrations are acknowledged with healthy food. If parents want to provide food for children's birthday celebrations we request as an alternative to cake that they provide plain popcorn, a fruit platter, fairy bread, mini muffins, or food similar. We will always make your child feel special as part of the celebration. We have a peanut-free policy. When providing food for celebrations please include a copy of the ingredients or recipe as we need this for our allergy records.

Food guidelines to reduce choking hazards. Please do not bring these foods to the centre:

- Crisps, chippies, corn chips, popcorn, peanuts.
- Marshmallows, hard or chewy sweets & Iollies.
- Hard crackers (under 3 years)
- Whole nuts (under 3 years)

CLOTHES

Please dress your child in clothes designed for play (it will be messy at times), and provide a spare set of named clothing in a named bag. Provide a named sunhat in summer please.

INFANTS & TODDLERS

Please provide bottles, food and disposable or cloth nappies. Our disposable nappies are composted at Rangiora.

PAYMENTS

Weekly accounts are emailed. These show a weekly invoice, recent payments and the balance due. Payments are by Direct Credit or Automatic Payment on the internet.

Please use your child's name as the reference on the internet payment. Fees are due weekly or fortnightly.

While settling full fees are waived for the first 4 sessions, you will be charged only for the reduced amount of time you and your child attend. Full fees are payable from the 5th session on.

HOLIDAYS

We are closed for Public Holidays, including Show Day. We are open through all School Holidays, except Christmas, when closing times are for about two weeks. Dates are to be notified each year.





BOOKING COMMITMENTS

Minimum booking times are for TWO days. Your booking is permanent and must be paid for until cancelled with TWO weeks written notice. Keep to booking times as changes affect our staff/ child ratios and licensing capacity.

ABSENCES

If a child is absent, full fees are payable for the booked time.

If a family has bookings for 20 hours or more and the Centre has one weeks notice of an absence then half fees are payable, for up to four weeks per year, providing they are not consecutive for more than three weeks. If you are absent for more than three weeks in a row, please advise our centre as MOE funding stops and you will need to pay full fees to retain the booking.

There are no half fees for children accessing 20 Hours ECE. Please notify us if your child will not be attending. No fee is charged for Statutory Holidays or for the closure at Christmas.

OUTINGS

All excursions require parents signed permission prior to each outing. Staff to child ratios are posted on outing forms for your approval before signing.

SICKNESS

The Centre will publicise any common infectious diseases which children may be exposed to during their time at the Centre. Children may not attend if they are sick. Children must be free of symptoms for at least 48 hours if they have had a fever, rash, sticky eyes, diarrhea or vomiting.

IMMUNISATIONS

Children who are not immunised (for all or some diseases) and are therefore at risk of disease will be required to stay away from the centre when there are cases of a vaccine preventable disease e.g. measles, mumps. The public Health Service will work with the centre and advise when these children can return to the centre. During this time normal fees will be charged and you will need to have an alternative arrangement for your child.

ATTENDANCE REGISTER

It is important that you sign in your child each day upon arrival and enter arrival time, then sign out when leaving and enter the time you depart. Daily attendance must be for a minimum of six hours on a regular basis. We may not claim full funding for children who do not attend to this pattern.

We are dedicated to providing quality education and childcare, so please immediately discuss with us any concern that you may have.

Please note that parents and caregivers are welcome to visit at any time.

We trust that your time with us will be a happy one.
